

In the six-day period ending Tuesday, February 17th, at 4:00 p.m., 3.73 inches of rain fell in Oakland, bringing our percent of normal precipitation to 87% of normal for the same period.

For the remainder of the week the forecast is mostly cloudy, changing to partly cloudy with winds light and variable. Rain is expected on Sunday, February 22nd.

There were 86 service requests which consisted primarily of flooding conditions due to clogged storm drains. Of these, there were 21 tree incidents consisting of 13 trees down and 8 limbs fallen at various locations around the City, cleared by the Tree Division. One large tree trunk, located at 7051 Skyline, was pushed out of the travel-way and coned for visibility. Trunk is to be removed by Friday, February 20th.

There were a total of 51 incidents regarding plugged storm drains or inlets, of which 48 incidents have been completed with the remaining in progress. There were a total of 5 incidents of minor rock and mud slides at Buckingham, Skyline Blvd. and Tunnel Road, all were coned off and three have been removed. The slides encroached into the roadways, but none caused road closures.
